This Indenture made and entered into on this 1st day of February 1827 By & between Henry Hunt of the one part and Jacob Barnes of the other part each party of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Henry Hunt in consideration of the sum of twenty five dollars to him in hand paid by the said Jacob Barnes before the enrolling and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns his the said Henry Hunt's right title interest & estate in and to a certain tract or Lot of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and bounded by the lands of the following named persons to wit Benjamin Jordan Reubin Whitfield the heirs of Samuel Dick and Supposed to contain about thirty acres To have and to hold his right title & interest as aforesaid in and to the above described Tract or Lot of Land with all appurtenances thereto in full and singular other the premises here and before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of his rights, liberties and appurtenances unto him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever and the said Henry Hunt for himself and his heirs the said interest in and to the above described Tract or Lot of Land the same being Equal to one fifth of the whole land described as aforesaid with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs free from the claim or claims of him the said Henry Hunt his heirs and assigns and also free from the claim or claims of all and every person whatsoever with and do warrant and forever defend by these presents.
