alloties to me as adm. of my dead wife Elizabeth Barrow formerly Elizabeth Cland
witness whereof I have hereunto affixed my hand and seal this 22 day of June 1827

This Indenture made this 20th day of Feb^y in the year of our Lord 1827. Between Wm
H. Briggs of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part Joseph
Clanton of County of Sussex and State aforesaid of the second part and William L. Rockelle
of the County of Southampton and State aforesaid of the third part Whereas the said
William H. Briggs is justly indebted to Wm Clanton in the sum of Forty Two dollars
and fifty eight Cents and the said William L. Rockelle being his Security for the
same is apprehensive that he shall have said sum of money to pay and the said
William H. Briggs being desirous effectually to assure and secure to the said William
L. Rockelle the debt aforesaid due and owing to the said Wm Clanton together
with the interest and Costs which shall or may accrue thereon also all Costs attending
the execution of this Trust and this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consi-
deration of the premises and also for the further consideration of one dollar of lawful
money of Virginia to the said William H. Briggs in hand paid by the said
Joseph Clanton at and before the sealing and delivery of the 20 presents the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said William H. Briggs hath given grant
bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released and Confirmed and by these presents doth
give grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and Confirm to the said Joseph Clanton
his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of Land lying & being
in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia siting a part of the tract
of Land said William H. Briggs purchased of William W. Rapert containing sixty
acres to the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Thomas Moore Loe Rockelle
and Samuel Parham and all the estate right title and interest of the said William H.
Briggs in and to the said granted or intended to be hereby granted tract or parcel of Land
and premises. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land and premises with its
appurtenances to the said Joseph Clanton his heirs Executors and assigns forever to the
only proper use and behoof of the said Joseph Clanton his heirs &c. forever and the
William H. Briggs for himself his heirs Executors and adm. doth hereby Covenant
promise and agree to and with the said Joseph Clanton his heirs &c. forever in
manner and form following that is to say that the said William H. Briggs his heirs
&c. the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises with its appurtenances unto the
said Joseph Clanton his heirs &c. against all persons whatsoever shall and well warrant
forever defend by then presents upon Trust nevertheless that the said Joseph Clanton
shall permit the said William H. Briggs to remain in quiet and peaceable possession
of the said tract of Land and take the profits thereof to his own use until such time
be made in the payment of the said sum of Forty two dollars & fifty
