This Indenture made this 17<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year of our Lord  
Christ 1827 Between Herod Dole of the first part the debtor Benjamin Griffin  
Trustee of the second part and Patrick Dole son of Elizabeth Dole of the third part  
Whereas the said Herod Dole is jointly indebted to the said Patrick Dole as here  
aforesaid in the joint sum of one hundred twenty eight dollars sixty four cents  
due by note bearing date the 1<sup>st</sup> day of February 1827 payable nine months after  
date Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one  
dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said Herod Dole on hand paid by the said  
Benjamin Griffin Trustee at or before the encoding and delivery of these presents the  
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Herod Dole the debtor hath given  
granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain & sell unto  
the said Benjamin Griffin Trustee his heirs and assigns forever the following property  
to wit one tract of Land containing eighty five and three quarters acres which is part  
aces of John Baykin two feather beds and furniture two tables one Bed and  
saddle two iron Pots and spades two chest of trunk one Cart wheels eight chains  
two axes one dagger plough and one turn To have and to hold the said hereby granted property  
unto the said Benjamin Griffin Trustee his heirs Executors and assigns forever  
and the said Herod Dole for himself his heirs Executors and assigns doth hereby  
warrant promise and agree to and with the said Benjamin Griffin his heirs Executors  
and assigns forever in manner and form following to wit that the said Herod Dole  
his heirs Executors and assigns the aforesaid property unto the said Benjamin Griffin  
his heirs Executors and assigns against all persons whatsoever and shall and lawfully  
and forever defend by these presents upon trust nevertheless that the said Benjamin  
Griffin his heirs Executors and assigns shall permit the said Herod Dole to remain in  
quiet and peaceable possession of the above named property and take the profits thereof  
to his own use until default be made in the payment of the before mentioned  
sum of One hundred twenty eight dollars & 64 cents unto the said Patrick Dole  
the Creditor and then upon this further trust that the said Benjamin Griffin  
his heirs Executors and assigns shall and will as soon after the happening of such  
default of payment as he may think proper or the Patrick Dole his heirs  
and assigns may request sell the before mentioned property for ready money  
at public auction after having fixed the time and place of sale by giving  
ten days notice thereof at the Court house door of the County of Southampton
