willing to secure the true payment thereof have as will for the aforesaid sum
of three hundred thirty seven dollars and twenty three cents as also one dollar to remain
paid by John Jey the trust whereof is hereby acknowledged I the said Francis
Clements have granted bargained sold and by these presents do grant bargain & sell
the said John Jey the following negroes to wit Mary Calbraud Daniel in these
Trust & consideration to the intent and purpose that if the aforesaid sum of three
hundred and thirty seven dollars and twenty three cents shall remain unpaid to the
said John Reese his heirs &c shall after giving legal notice upon the aforesaid
negroes to public sale at any time after 1st March next and with the one penny
therefrom first to pay and satisfy the aforesaid sum of three hundred & thirty seven
dollars twenty three cents as also the expense attending the execution of this Trust
and the surplus of any return to me my heirs &c. In testimony whereof we have

C. Jones of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Edward
for & in consideration of six dollars to him in hand paid by the said Thomas
Jones at and before the enrolling and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
he doth hereby acknowledge the said William Edward hath granted bargained
sold aliened and confirmed and doth by these presents grant bargain sell alien and
confirm unto the said Thomas C. Jones his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract
or parcel of land lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton on the west side
of the Lynch Swamp containing by survey one acre twenty nine & 1/2⁰⁰ of the Rod to
the same more or less within following bounds (Viz) Beginning at a large pine tree near the
thence South 63 E 10 Pole to a red oak thence S 1/4 E 16 pole to a large water oak thence S 69
W 14 P 48 1/2 to the centre of the road thence N 2 E 24 pole to the beginning together with
all and singular the appurtenances privileges profits and emoluments to the same then
or from the same in any manner issuing or proceeding To have and to hold the said land
premises with the appurtenances aforesaid to him the said Thomas C. Jones his heirs and
assigns forever and he the said William Edward for himself his heirs heirs heirs and
assigns will by these presents warrant and defend the said bargained premises against the lawful
claim or demand of all and every person whatsoever to him the said Thomas C. Jones
