This Indenture made this 8th day of December in the Year of our Lord 1826 between Andrew Woodley and Elizabeth H. Woodley his wife of the County of Gloucester and State of Virginia of the first part and James Turner a Freeman of Odessa of the County of Southampton and State aforesaid of the second part witnesseth that the said Andrew Woodley and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and dollars to them in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the parties acknowledge have granted bargained & sold and by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said James Turner as aforesaid his heirs and assigns forever a certain piece or parcel of Land Containing one acre more or less situate lying and being in the County of Southampton which said piece or parcel of land lies in part of the main road leading from Jerusalem to X Keys and Belfield and adjoining the lands of on the the west and the lands of on the south and east and for a further description of said Land & where it may be had to be had from Francis H. Woodley To have and to hold the said piece or parcel of Land to the said James Turner his heirs and assigns forever and the said Andrew Woodley and Elizabeth his wife for themselves their heirs &c do covenant & agree to and with the said James Turner his heirs &c that they will forever warrant & defend the title of the said piece or parcel of Land against the claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever, In witness whereof the said Andrew Woodley and Elizabeth his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day & year first above written
