This Indenture made this 20<sup>th</sup> day of March in the year of our Lord 1827  
Between William McLandsish, Marshal of the Superior Court of Chancery for  
the Williamsburg District of the one part and John Boytin of the other part  
Witnesseth that the said William McLandsish in pursuance of a decree of the  
said Court of Chancery for the district aforesaid pronounced on the tenth day of  
our thousand eight hundred and twenty six in the case of Boytin against Strong  
field and others and of a sale made by him by virtue of said decree by public auction  
of the said land at which the said John Boytin became the purchaser for the  
sum of fifty dollars and in consideration of the said sum of fifty dollars to him  
in hand paid by the said John Boytin before the sealing and delivery of these  
presents hath given granted bargained and sold aliened released enfeoffed confirmed  
and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell alien release enfeoff and  
confirm unto the said John Boytin his heirs and assigns the said tract  
of land above mentioned situated in the County of Southampton being the  
land conveyed by William Strongfield to Benjamin Jones by deed dated the  
20<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year 1816 containing fifty five acres more or less  
together with all and singular the buildings ways easements hereditaments &  
appurtenances whatsoever to the said land belonging or in any wise appertain-  
ing and the reversions and reversion remainders and remainders yearly & other  
rents issues and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof To have  
and to hold the said lands with the tenements hereditaments and all things  
other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained & sold unto  
the said John Boytin his heirs and assigns forever To and for the only proper  
use and behoof of him the said John Boytin his heirs and assigns forever  
And that free and clear of all claim and incumbrance by the said William  
McLandsish and all persons claiming by through or under him and next  
otherwise In witness whereof the said William McLandsish Marshal  
as aforesaid hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day & year first  
above written

sell unto the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns their and each of their  
interest in a certain tract or lot of Land lying and being in the aforesaid  
County of Southampton and bounded by the Land of the following  
person to wit Benjamin Jordan Rentin Whilfield the heirs of  
Nock de cally triox and James Fick and supposed to contain about
