these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Have bargained
sold and by these presents doth bargain & sell unto the said Jordan Spivey
his heirs & assigns one certain tract or parcel of Land lying & being
in the County of Southampton and parish of Stolloway containing
by estimation Seventy acres more or less and bounded on the east by
Blackwater River South by the land of Thomas Herring on the
west by the land of William Sumpter and on the north by the land
of John Boyd formerly Jones place reference being had to former deed
well more fully appear together with all and singular the ^{out houses} houses edifices buildings
yards gardens ways water and water courses orchards lands woods purchased
profits Commodities advantages emoluments here detractions and appurtenances
to the said land belonging or in anywise appertaining to the same or any
part thereof To have and to hold the said 70 acres of Land with the tenements heredi-
taments and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned
with every part and parcel thereof unto the said Jordan Spivey his heirs and
assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Jordan
Spivey his heirs and assigns forever and the said John Boyd as Exor aforesaid
for himself his heirs the said land with all and singular the premises herein
before mentioned unto the said Jordan Spivey his heirs and assigns free from
the claim or claims of him the said John Boyd or his heirs and all & every
other person or persons whatsoever shall with and do warrant and forever defend
