This Indenture made this 20th day of December in the year of our Lord 1826 between Moses Thorpe and Sarah his wife of the County of Greenville of the one part & David Westbrook of the County of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that the said Moses Thorpe and Sarah his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred & thirty dollars and 50/100 Current money of Virginia to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain & sell unto the said David Westbrook his heirs &c a certain tract of Land containing one hundred and forty two acres more or less situated and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows viz on the north by the land of John Barham on the east by the land of said Westbrook on the south by the land of William A. Jones and on the west by the land of Jesse Host together with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging to have and to hold the said bargained premises with the appurtenances aforesaid unto the said David Westbrook his heirs &c and the said Moses Thorpe and Sarah his wife for themselves and their heirs the aforesaid granted tract of land with all & singular the appurtenances as above mentioned unto David Westbrook his heirs &c and the said Moses Thorpe and Sarah his wife for themselves and their heirs the aforesaid granted Tract of land with all & singular the appurtenances as above mentioned unto David Westbrook his heirs &c free from the claim or claims of all and every person or persons shall warrant & forever defend by these presents In testimony whereof the said Moses Thorpe and Sarah his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and date first written
