Agreeably to the last will and testament of Thomas Brown decd (late of Southampton County Virginia) We the undersigned Legates to the last will being of lawful age have Chosen Lewis McCorrell William Ferguson & Mili (all three) our neighbors with the assistance of Thomas McMorrell Surveyor to divide the land of said decedent as expressed in said will which they have done in the following manner viz whole Tract contains eighty four acres. Town Lot #1 containing 15 acres allotted to Lucy Brown widow and relict of said decedent being equal value to 1/2 part of the whole tract of land and bounded as follows.
