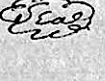


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in the South side of Round Hill Swamp a corner
 hundred and fifty acres and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a Cypress Tree between
 the said Samuel Jones and Robert Denny thence up a branch between the said Jones
 & Denny to a fork thence up the west prong of the said branch to the head thereof
 thence along a line of marked trees to a gum a corner tree in Bennetts line thence along
 said Bennetts line of marked trees to Dr Branch thence down the said Branch to a
 hightwood stump a corner in Raiford ^{thence along said Raiford line} line of marked trees to a gum a corner tree
 in said line thence along the said Raiford line to a small white oak in Henry
 Lenon line thence along said Lenon's line to the aforesaid James Claytons line
 thence along the said Claytons line to a gum a corner tree standing in a Branch
 thence along said Claytons line of marked trees to a Branch thence down the
 branch to a pine standing in the head of the Duck Pond a corner tree between the
 said Clayton and Parden's heirs thence along the said Parden's line of marked
 trees to a Branch thence down the branch to the main run of Seacoast Swamp
 thence up the various courses of the run of the said Swamp to Round Hill
 Swamp thence up the various of the run of the said Round Hill Swamp to the
 beginning with all houses barns stables buildings yards gardens (with the
 only exception of the family grave yard) also with orchards lands tenements
 pastures woods water water courses, privileges profits commodities advantages
 emoluments hereditaments and appurtenances whatever (with the exception
 only as above mentioned) to the said Tract piece or parcel of Land belonging to
 appertaining thereto and the reversion and reversions remainder of remainder
 rents issues and profits thereof and of every part thereof To have and to hold the
 said tract or parcel of Land with the tenements hereditaments and all and
 singular other the premises herein before mentioned with every of their rights members
