This Indenture made and entered into on this 16th day of September in the year of our Lord 1826 by and between Mason Bishop and Elizabeth his wife whose maiden name was Elizabeth Vick of the one part and Selah Ellsworth of the other part both parties hereto of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia. This Indenture witnesseth that the said Mason Bishop and Elizabeth his wife in consideration of the sum of seventy dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Selah Ellsworth at or before the executing of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain sell unto the said Selah Ellsworth his heirs and assigns all the right title interest of estate which they the said Mason Bishop and Elizabeth his wife have and to a certain legacy bequeathed to the said Elizabeth by her Grandfather Arthur Vick in and by his last will and Testament which will is of record in the Clerk's Office for the aforesaid County of Southampton To have and to hold the said interest in and to the said legacy bequeathed by and in manner aforesaid unto him the said Selah Ellsworth his heirs and assigns forever and the said Mason Bishop and Elizabeth his wife for themselves and their heirs the said bequeathed legacy whether it shall eventually be in land or money with all the right title interest and estate unto the said Selah Ellsworth his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every person or persons who shall or do and do warrant and for or defend by these presents in witness whereof the said Mason Bishop and Elizabeth his wife have hereunto set their hand and seals the day and year first above written
