This Indenture made and entered into on this 28th day of January 1826 between
 Lewis Brown and Polly Brown his wife of the County of Southampton and State of
 Virginia of the one part and Lewis Morrell of the same County and State of the other part
 Witnesseth that the said Lewis Brown and Polly Brown his wife for and in con-
 sideration of the sum of one hundred dollars current money of the Commonwealth to
 them in hand paid by the said Lewis at or before the executing and delivery of
 these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained
 and sold and by these presents do grant bargain & sell alien enfeof and confirm
 unto him the said Lewis Morrell and his heirs forever one certain tract or
 parcel of Land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton
 and Parish of Saint Lukes containing by a late survey twenty seven acres to
 the same more or less it being lot 2 in the division of the lands of Thomas
 Brown deceased Father of said Lewis Brown which was drawn by himself the said
 Lewis Brown and bounded as follows To wit Beginning at a black gum tree
 in the run of the little Swamp a new corner of Edith Brown lot in said Lewis
 Morrell's line thence along said Edith Brown's line 585 & 50 poles to a black gum tree
 the house a new corner of said Edith Brown & Lucy Brown lot thence along
 Lewis Morrell's line 57 1/4 & 31 1/2 poles to a gum pine thence 586 1/2 poles
 to dead pine thence 532 1/2 poles to a large gum pine standing in
 the pond thence up the run of said little Swamp the various corners
