This Indenture made this 3rd day of August in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty four Between Soan in Council and Phoebe his wife of the County of Isle of Wight and state of Virginia of the one parts, and Joseph S Council of Southampton County and state aforesaid of the other parts, Witnesseth that the said Soan Council and Phoebe his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred dollars to them in hand paid, or secured to be paid by the said Joseph S Council, before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and themselves wherewith to be fully satisfied, and paid and thereof doth clearly acquit and discharge the said Joseph S Council, his heirs & assigns forever by these presents doth grant bargain & sell infirmly and confirm unto the said Joseph S Council his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing by estimation, two hundred and eleven acres be the same more or less, and bounded as followeth to wit: Beginning at a bay tree on the South side of Tarpon Branch thence along a line of marked trees to a black oak a corner tree Eastward in Charles Bailey's line, thence along said Bailey's line to Robert Harris line, thence along said Harris line, to Simon Boykin's line to Tarpon Branch, thence up the main run of the said Branch to the beginning.
