Hundley of the one part and William Mills of the other part all of the County of Southampton and Parish of Stolloway, Wilmersburgh that the said Thomas Hundley & Solly his wife in consideration of the sum of one thousand and thirty five dollars of Lawful money of this Commonwealth, to them in hand paid by the said William Mills at or before the making and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold and by these presents do each of them bargain and sell unto the said William Mills his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County and Parish aforesaid containing by estimation One Hundred Acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of William Mills Mills Denon and The Down land owned by Elizabeth Mills (late Turner) reference to former deeds in the Clerk's office being had well more fully appears, together with all and singular the houses out houses, yards, Gardens, Orchards, Woods ways, waters, and water courses privileges, profits commodities advantages hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said land belonging or in anywise appertaining to the same in any part or parcel thereof.
