This Indenture made this 5 day of August in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty six between Thomas Prillow and Jane his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Johnson Pope of the County & State aforesaid of the other parts Witnesseth That for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and eighty dollars Current money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Johnson Pope at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged) Have bargained & sold, and by these presents do, and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Johnson Pope his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of Land being and lying in the County aforesaid and bounded as follows on the South by the land of said Thomas Prillow known by the name of Grayland on the East by the lands of said Thomas Prillow and Jane Prillow known by the name of the Kitchen Strad. On the North by the land of George Garoma and on the West by the land of Arrington Goodner orphan of James Garoma decd. Containing seventy six Acres, be the same more or less it being the land which I purchased of Henry Simpson together with all and singular the appurtenances whatsoever to the said land belonging or appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders yearly and other rents, issues and profits thereof, and every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the tract or parcel of Land with the tenements hereditaments & all and singular other premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold, and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Johnson Pope his heirs and assigns forever.
