 sideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty one dollars & ninety three cents
 current money of Virginia to him in hand paid the rec^d. The said Thomas White
 and Margaret his wife doth hereby acknowledge. The said Thomas White & Margaret
 his wife have hereunto bargained and sold alien'd and conveyed unto the said
 Stephen Johnson his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land
 being in the County of Southampton and on Blackwater river (to wit) begin-
 ning at a hickory on Blackwater river thence a line of marked trees in the
 Whites line to a pine a corner tree on Jonathan Suters line thence a line of
 marked trees in said Suters line to a red oak a corner of Suters and Lawrence
 thence a line of marked trees to a pine on Lawrence's line thence said line to
 Blackwater River thence down said river to the first station containing
 were to the same more or less which the said Stephen Johnson is to have and
 hold with all woods underwoods, way waters water courses houses and other
