hundred and twenty seven. Between Amey Bird and Sophia Bird of the one part and Nathan Pope Jr of
the other part: all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that for and in
consideration of the sum of one dollar but more especially for and in consideration of the sum of
two hundred and twenty five dollars good and lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in
hand paid by the Nathan Pope Jr at and before the indenting & delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof they the said Amey Bird and Sophia Bird doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit
and discharge the said Nathan Pope Jr. from further payment in this behalf, have granted bar-
gained & sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Nathan Pope Jr
him and his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of Land Situate lying and being in
the parish of Nottoway and County of Southampton Containing seventy five acres to the
same more or less it being the same tract piece of parcel of Land which the said Amey ac-
quired title to for & during her natural life by the said Sophia after her mother's death (the said
Amey Bird) to her the said Sophia and her heirs forever, by and from John Denigro and heirs
which deed is duly recorded in the Clerk's office of this County, reforming the same to be
the boundaries here appear in the following manner (Viz) Bounded by the lines of
Thomas Camp Griffin Dick Wells Murfee James Darnolds and the formerly known
boundary which is the line of Anna Stephenson To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of
Land with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging to him the said
