This Indenture made this 5th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven between Charlotte Westbrook a free woman of the County of Southampton of the one part and George Barclay of the County of said of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Charlotte Westbrook for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five Dollars to her in hand paid by the said George Barclay. the receipt whereof she the said Charlotte Westbrook doth hereby acknowledge. hath granted bargained and sold and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said George Barclay a certain Tract or Parcel of Land whereon the said Charlotte Westbrook formerly resided being the remainder of the Land devised her by her late master William Westbrook and bounded by the Land of Benjamin Lewis dec^d. Armand Jones formerly Thomas McDottle and the Land whereon the said George Barclay at present resides situate lying and being in the County of Southampton containing fifteen and two 2/10 Acres be the same more or less Together with all the houses and Garden, Yards, Orchards whatsoever belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said Tract or Parcel of Land and premises aforesaid to have and to hold the same to him and his heirs forever and the said Charlotte Westbrook doth for herself her heirs Executors and administrators Covenant and agree to and with the said George Barclay his heirs and assigns that she will by these presents Warrant and forever defend all right title claim or demand of any person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or part thereof of or from her or her heirs or assigns which the said Charlotte Westbrook hath heretofore set her hand and seal the day and year first above written

This Indenture made and entered into on this day of March in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven by and between Polly Jackson selling Party and Jacob Barnes buying party each of whom are of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Polly Jackson in consideration of the sum of thirty five Dollars to her in hand paid by the said Jacob Barnes at the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. have bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns a certain Lot of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and bounded as follows To wit. Beginning at a pine tree which is as for nearly a corner tree of John Jackson in Arthur Whitehead's line it now being a corner tree in Sally Knowles line thence nearly an East Course along Sally Knowles line of marked trees to a certain Pine tree as fore and aft in said line no more a corner in said in said Sally Knowles line between the selling and buying parties herein thence nearly a South Course a new line of marked trees between selling and buying parties herein to James Williams line thence along said Williams line of marked trees meandering like a west course to the said Sally Knowles line thence nearly a North Course along said Knowles line which was formerly John Jackson's and Arthur Whitehead's line to the beginning which the above bounded line is supposed to contain about twelve acres of Land though as to the selling or buying parties either of their heirs or assigns is mutually not together with all and every advantage profit and emolument thereunto belonging or appertaining unto him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns for him and them to have and to hold the said Lot or Parcel of Land described as above with the Testaments he maintaineth and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold hereby
