one part and John Barrett of the same County & State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said  
Jonas Cosley and Priscilla Cosley his wife in consideration of five hundred Dollars to them  
in hand paid by the said John Barrett et al before the reciting and delivery of these presents  
the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold unto these present  
and each of us with Bargain and sell unto said John Barrett his heirs and springs certain  
tract as parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing  
by estimation one hundred seventeen and a half acres to the same more or less and  
boundaries as follow (To wit) on the North by John Barnes on North East by the Lands of  
Jacob Barrett et al on the East by the Lands of Jacob Davis et al & on the South by the said  
Davis Davis & on the South West by Jacob Barrett & et al Land which boundaries will  
more fully appear by reference to a deed of Bargain & sale from Basy <sup>a</sup> Whitefield Dec<sup>d</sup>. to the said  
Jonas Cosley an twenty acres of the aforesaid Land was given to the said Cosley by said Basy  
Whitefield dec<sup>d</sup>. which will appear by reference to said Whitefield's last will. Together with all right  
title interest, claim of demand of in and to the said tract, or parcel of Land and premises with its  
Appurtenances there belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold the aforesaid  
tract or parcel of Land and premises with its Appurtenances thereunto belonging unto him the said  
John Barrett his heirs and springs forever to use and behoof of him the  
said John Barrett his heirs and springs forever and the said Jonas Cosley and his wife  
for themselves their heirs Executors Admin<sup>r</sup> and Cessing as herby covenant and agree to  
and with the said John Barrett his Executors Admin<sup>r</sup> and Cessing that they will by  
these presents warrant and for ever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel  
of land and premises and every part or parcel thereof against the claim or demands of any  
every person or persons whatsoever. In witness whereof the said Jonas Cosley & Priscilla  
his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and date first written.
