This Indenture made this tenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty six between Peter Booth of the County of Southampton of the first part and Shadrach Boykin of the said County of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Peter Booth is an appointed Trustee in a deed of Trust executed by Abraham Biddle to the said Shadrach Boykin who was his security in a certain Bond executed by Benjamin Carrell as expressed in said deed of Trust and whereas the said Peter Booth as aforesaid hath been required by the said Shadrach Boykin to proceed in said deed of Trust the said tract of land mentioned in the said deed of Trust to be sold to the highest price for money for the benefit of the said Shadrach Boykin and which land was accordingly sold up to the highest bidder on the 27th day of July last and was bought by the said Shadrach Boykin for the sum of three hundred and five Dollars.
