Jones upon being thereof notified by the aforesaid Patrick Pond shall proceed to see all the right and interest of the said Samuel Bailey to the above named Negroes hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed after deducting from place in the said County of Southampton for ten days previous at some publick Auction for Cash and out of the money arising out of from the said sale in the first place pay satisfy all cost attending the said sale as well as the expenses attending the said conveyance then pay off the bond aforesaid as well as all other monies which may appear to be due from the said Samuel Bailey to the said Patrick Pond by means of any drafts transfer any debt or paper whatever and the surplus if any pay to the said Samuel Bailey or the said Samuel Bailey for himself his heirs Executors and Administrators the residue of the said Negroes unto the said Thomas C. Jones his heirs and assigns forever and hereby Warrant and defend against the lawful claim or claims of him the said Samuel Bailey his heirs Executors and Administrators and against all and every other persons persons whomsoever and the said Thomas C. Jones on his part covenants and agrees that he will make use of the right and interest hereby conveyed for the best price he can obtain for the same after advertising the time and place for ten days previous at some publick Auction Store in the said County and with the monies arising from the said first pay and satisfy all cost attending the same as well as the expenses attending the conveyance and pay off the aforesaid Bond and interest as well as all monies which may appear to be due from the said Thomas C. Jones to be justly due and owing from the said Samuel Bailey to the said Patrick Pond by means of any drafts transfer of assets or paper whatever and then pay the surplus if any to the said Samuel Bailey and the said Thomas C. Williams of two hundred and thirty four Dollars & eighteen Cents due by Note bearing date the 20th of January 1826 and the said Turner Newsome being willing and desirous to satisfy the aforesaid sum of two hundred and thirty four Dollars & eighteen Cents with interest from the said Indenture further do stipulate that the said Turner Newsome hath been and is in the possession of one Dollar in hand paid by the said John R. Williams who was mutually satisfied back of said note and bargain and by these presents doth grant bargain sell unto the said John R. Williams or to his heirs Executors Administrators
