This Indenture made this twenty first day of May one thousand eight hundred & twenty seven  
 between John Nicholson of the one part & Drury Biddle & Bond in Partner of the other part all of  
 the County of Southampton. Witnesseth that whereas the said Drury Biddle Esq of Margaret  
 Simmons dec<sup>d</sup> hath a bond against the said John Nicholson for the sum of three hundred & forty  
 three Dollars & thirty one Cents bearing date the twenty first Day of May one thousand & twenty seven  
 which the said John Nicholson doth acknowledge to be just and he the said John Nicholson  
 being willing and desirous to secure and save harmless the said Drury Biddle from any loss  
 or injury which he may sustain and for the further consideration of one Dollar to him the said  
 John Nicholson in hand paid at and before the seal aforesaid and delivery of these presents the  
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said John Nicholson hath bargained & granted sold  
 & confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and confirm unto the said Drury  
 Biddle his heirs Executors assigns or assigns of Land lying in the County of Southampton  
 containing one hundred and forty Acres be the same more or less together with two  
 Leather Beds & a wooden one Table one chest one Desk set of six Earthen ware two Iron pots one  
 Dutch oven one frying pan & Skillets two saws & 17 miles one Cow and Yearling one Cow  
 one pair of Cards one Spinning wheel & four Barrels of Corn all of the above mentioned property  
 belonging unto the said John Nicholson the right and title whereof he the said John Nicholson  
 warrant and will for ever defend unto the said Drury Biddle his heirs and assigns forever  
 Notwithstand of this special Trust and confidence and no other that is to say if at any time  
 the said Drury Biddle should be in evident danger of losing the said Bond or any part  
 thereof it shall be lawful for the said Drury Biddle to direct Edward Barnes Trustee to  
 this Debt and or mortgaged of the aforesaid Land and all the other property contained in this  
 Debt after giving the said John Nicholson ten days publick notice of the sale of said  
 Land and property for Cash and with the proceeds of the sale first pay and satisfy  
 the amount due to the execution of this Debt then is authorized to pay the before mentioned debt  
 and if there should be any surplus remaining the same is to be paid unto the said John  
 Nicholson or his representatives and the said John Nicholson for himself his heirs Executors  
 and assigns doth covenant and agreed to and with said Drury Biddle to warrant  
 & defend the right and title in and to the above conveyed Land and other property against  
 the claim and demand of all and every person whatsoever in witness whereof the parties
