Urquhart and before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is fully acknowledged and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Richard A. Urquhart his heirs Executors and assigns all that tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton (designated from my other lands by the name of "Lot 1" and containing by estimation Eight hundred and Forty acres be the same more or less and part of the said tract of Land which is on the north side of Warwick Swamp and adjoining the Land whereon I now live. It being the tract of Land bought of Thomas Smith a reference to that deed executed by the said Thomas Smith to the said John Urquhart and the boundaries of the said tract of Land To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land unto him the said R. A.
