Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by the said Henry Harris the receipt is hereby acknowledged by the said Alexander P. Peto both present bargained and by these presents do grant bargain sell and confirm unto the said Henry Harris his heirs and assigns certain tract or parcel of land ^{lying} situate being in the County of Southampton and on the North side of the three Creeks and bounded as follows to wit on the South by the three Creeks West by the lands of Thiophasius Peto Mark T. Peto North by George M. Peto East by the lands of the aforesaid Alexander Peto it being a part of the land owned by Capt. Thomas Peto and drawn by his two Daughters Martha and Elizabeth Peto containing one hundred and twenty acres or thereabouts more or less with all the improvements and profits thereunto belonging to have and to hold unto the said Henry Harris his heirs and assigns from which said Land I the said Alexander P. Liles from the above named John Britt by the said Alexander Myrick at and before the making and delivery of these presents the full receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the selling party herein who have in consideration thereof bargained & sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto him the said Alexander Myrick his heirs and assigns as follows that is to say they the said Saml. Liles John Britt and Mary his wife do by these presents grant bargain sell alienate and confirm unto the said Alexander Myrick his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land ^{lying} situate and being in the County Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke and bounded by the lands of the following named persons to wit Germ. Everett. William S. Price Davis Myrick and the above named Alexander Myrick and supposed to contain eighty five acres of land more or less the said land being all that which was bequeathed the said
