This Indenture made the 2nd day of March 1827 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven Between Edwin Drake and Sally his wife of the County of Southampton and State of N.C. of the one part and Ridley Drake of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Edwin Drake and Sally his wife for and in the consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars to them in hand paid by the said Ridley Drake the receipt is hereby acknowledged both by him and wife and by these presents with grant bargain and sell unto the said Ridley Drake his heirs and assigns forever a certain Tract or parcel of Land containing Sixty one acres be that more or less lying and being on the North side of the Nottoway Swamp in the County of Southampton aforesaid and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a Red Oak & corner of James Edwards and Charles Bryant thence a line of marked trees to a black gum a corner in John Drake's standing in the horse Barn branch thence up the said branch to a white oak in Barnaba Drake's line thence to a sweet gum in Chisney's branch in James Scott and Barnaba Drake's line thence down the branch corner of the said branch to the first station And the said Edwin Drake and Sally his wife with full power warrant and defend the right and title of the said land unto the said Ridley Drake his heirs and assigns forever Given under my hand and seal this day and date above written &c
