household and Kitchen furniture Stock of Cattle and Sheep belonging to the said
Turner Newsome to have and to hold the aforesaid property to the said John C. Turner his
heirs forever be it therefore remembered that the said Wm J. Lee being bound to the
aforesaid Turner Newsome in a bond due to Nathan Thomas for the sum of
and the said Turner Newsome being willing and desirous to cause the said Wm J. Lee
bargained and sold as before mentioned unto John C. Turner as in and to the present
Crop of Cotton Corn household and Kitchen Furniture Stock of Cattle & Sheep now in
