This Indenture made this fourteenth day of April in the year of our Lord 1827 between Williams Vick of the one part and Joshua Vick of the other part Witnesseth that the said Williams Vick for and consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars have bargained and sold and by these presents doth hereby bargain sell alien in fee of release and set over and confirm unto the said Joshua Vick his heirs and assigns forever in certain Tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a Cypress standing at the head of George's Gulley thence west by a direct line to a corner at high water mark Eem Vicks line thence down the meanders of high water mark to a white oak a corner of James Rockwell's Land thence West along a line of marked trees to a corner Pine a corner of said Rockwell's Land thence S E along a line of marked trees to a Cypress standing by the side of Holloway River thence up the said River to the mouth of George's Gulley thence up the said Gulley to the beginning containing one hundred and fifty Acres be the same more or less together with all Houses out Houses Gardens Orchards ways waters and water courses Minors Minerals profits & Commodities thereunto in anywise appertaining to have and to hold the said bargained premises & every of the appurtenances unto the said Joshua Vick his heirs and assigns forever the said
