

George Gentry his heirs executors & assigns in and to have and to hold the above described property and every part & parcel thereof unto him the said George Gentry his heirs executors & assigns forever In Trust nevertheless that if the said Henry Johnson or any other person in his behalf shall will and truly pay the aforesaid debt Interest & costs attending at or before the time the said Jacob Barnes his executor administrator or assignee shall demand & require the payment of the above sum of twenty nine dollars fifty five Cents with the interest & cost as aforesaid that then and in that case this Indenture & every thing herein contained shall be void & of none effect but in case he the said Henry Johnson shall fail to pay the aforesaid debt together with the interest and costs which shall have accrued thereon & truly when thereto required by the said Jacob Barnes or some legal representative of his as aforesaid it shall then be lawful & not only so but the duty of him the said George Gentry his Executors or assigns to make sale of the above described property for cash giving at least Ten days previous public notice of the time and place of such sale by advertisement posted up in at least three public places in the neighborhood of the said Henry Johnson and of the monies raised by such sale first pay all costs attending the execution of this Trust then pay and discharge the aforesaid debt & interest which shall have accrued thereon & if surplus money thereafter remain in the hands of the said George Gentry his executors or assigns as the case may be the same shall be paid over to the said Henry Johnson or his legal representative & in case the aforesaid debt Interest and Costs as aforesaid shall be paid prior to such sale as aforesaid then the said George Gentry his Exec or assigns shall release to the said Johnson or his heirs the above named property the title of which is hereby transferred to him the said George Gentry and he the said Henry Johnson for himself & his heirs do hereby warrant and forever thereafter defend by these presents the right title interest and estate of in and to the above described property and every part thereof unto him the said George Gentry his Executors & assigns against the claim & claims of all and every person & persons whatsoever in witness whereof we the parties herein have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals the day and year herein first before written

Pope This Indenture made this 21<sup>st</sup> day of March for the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven between Reuben R Pope of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia of the first part Peter Edwards of the second part & Benjamin Edwards of the County and State aforesaid of the third part Whereas the said Reuben R Pope stands justly indebted to the said Benjamin Edwards in the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars due by bond on demand the first day of April Eighteen Hundred & twenty nine and the said Reuben R Pope being willing and desirous of securing the payment of the same now this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises & also for the further consideration of one dollar to the said Reuben R Pope in hand paid by the said Peter Edwards at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Reuben R Pope also with hereby we grant bargain and sell unto the said Peter Edwards a certain Tract or parcel of land whereon he now lives lying and being in the County and State aforesaid containing one hundred & fourteen Acres more or less & bounded by the lands of Benjamin Edwards James & John Nicholas To Have and to hold from him the said Reuben R Pope his heirs & assigns the above granted premises with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the only proper use & behoof of him the said Peter Edwards his heirs Exec & assigns upon Trust nevertheless that the said Peter Edwards his Exec & assigns shall permit the said Reuben R Pope to remain in quiet & peaceable possession of the said Tract or parcel of land & take the profits thereof until default be made of the payment of the said
