This Indenture made & entered into this the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May in the year of our Lord 1827 Between John A Hill of the first part Stephen Murdaugh & George G Gurley of the second part & William Blom of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Men of the said John A Hill hath been by Stephen Murdaugh deputy sheriff of Southampton County for the year 1827 taken in custody & held to bail (which by the Law he was bound to do) at the instance of Henry G Leavelle and the said Stephen Murdaugh & George G Gurley his bail thinking it practicable now to some shew does the said Hill being anxious & desirous also to do bargain and sell & by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said William Blom his heirs & assigns forever Three negroes to wit Phillis Toney & Henderson To have & to hold the said three negro slaves to him & his heirs forever for this special Trust & for no other viz that if the said Stephen Murdaugh & George G Gurley shall in any wise think themselves in any danger or more effectually actually to incur danger than the said William Blom his heirs & assigns at the request of the said Stephen Murdaugh or the said George G Gurley shall at any publick auction sell to the highest bidder the aforesaid slaves at Jerusalem giving at least twenty days notice of the sale thereof sell the aforesaid negro slaves to the highest bidder for Cash & the sum plus if any after discharging the debt aforesaid if it so may happen pay to the said John A Hill & the said John A Hill do warrant & forever defend the aforesaid negro slaves to wit Phillis Toney & Henderson to the said William Blom his heirs & assigns in special Trust aforesaid & the said William Blom do hereby agree with the parties hereto to agree & perform what is here Lawfully enjoined on him Witnesses our hands and seals 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 1827

This Indenture and entered into this seventh day of February eighteen hundred & twenty one between Amos Soyner & Nancy his wife of the one part & Abbigdon Harvey & Burwell Bantley of the other part Witnesses that the said Amos Soyner & Nancy his wife have for & in consideration of one dollar Current Money bargained & sold unto the said Abbigdon Harvey and Burwell Bantley of one certain Tract or piece of land containing by estimation one acre be the same more or less and bounded as follows beginning & running a South east corner to a light wood post thence running a north bound to a second light wood post and thence to the beginning To have and to hold the said land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular the premises therein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold with every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Abbigdon Harvey Burwell Bantley and their heirs & assigns for ever upon this special Trust and confidence nevertheless that they will hold the same for the special Trust occupation and benefit of the religious society of the known & distinguished by the appellation of Christians and also for the ministers of the gospel of every denomination whatsoever and the said Amos Soyner & Nancy his wife for themselves and their heirs the said piece of land with all and singular the premises herein before mentioned unto the said Abbigdon Harvey and Burwell Bantley and their heirs executors and administrators free from the claim of them the said Amos Soyner
