and ninety six Cents to him in hand well and truly paid by the said John Booth before the
making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted
bargained sold and by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said John Booth
his heirs execs. admr or assigns forever a certain Tract or parcel of land lying and being in
the County of Southampton containing ninety two Acres more or less of ^{high} said Tract or parcel
of land purchased by Edward Booth in his life time under a deed in Trust executed by
Wm P. Wallcut to Nathaniel Warham as Trustee for the benefit of Mr. Savage and which said
Tract or parcel of land is bounded by the lands of John Booth William Ricks Willis Wellons &c
it being the proportion of land assigned to Wm P. Wallcut from the Estate of his father John Warham
to hold the said Tract of land to the only proper use and behoof of him the said John Booth
his heirs and assigns forever and the said William P. Carleff Executor as aforesaid for myself
my heirs execs. & assigns the right and title to the said Land unto the said John Booth
his heirs and assigns forever against the claim of himself or against the claims of any
other person shall and will forever maintain and defend by these presents so far as the
right and title vests in him his executor of Edward Booth deceased and no further In

& twenty seven between Litchburg of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the
one part and Jesse Holt of the said County & State of the other part Witnesseth that for & in
consideration of the sum of nine hundred and twenty five dollars to the said Mason in hand
paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Mason hath granted bargained
and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell and confirm unto the said
Jesse Holt and his heirs forever One certain Tract or parcel of land it being one fourth
of Charles Botcholt's Tract of land which was allotted to his Daughter Evalina Botcholt
as her proportionable part lying on the south side of the Three Creeks bounded on the west
by the lands of said Holt on the East by the lands of Edwin P. Cloud by ring & being
in the aforesaid County containing two hundred & thirty Acres or there more or less
with all the improvements and benefits thereunto belonging to have and to hold unto
the said Jesse Holt his heirs and assigns forever which the said land & the said
Mason do warrant and forever defend the title of the said land to the said Holt
and his heirs forever against the claim of every person or persons whatsoever In wit-
