This Indenture made this day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven between Arrington Britt of the one part and Borodden of the other part both of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia wheras a certain Beisard Britt was jointly and severally bound unto the above named William in the sum of thirty three dollars & change to secure the payment of the same of him to him a debt in Truves in sum and his land and the above named Arrington Britt was the Trustee in sum and the above named Beisard Britt failed to pay to the said William Borodden the money the said and called for in his life time in consequence of which failure said William Borodden has ordered the above named Arrington Britt as Trustee to make sale of the twelve acres land which said and called for which he has now after giving due notice of the same for and in consideration of the sum of 12 dollars of Lawful money of this Commonwealth and the said William Borodden became the purchaser and shall pay the money the receipt whereof is hereby given to the said Arrington Britt as Trustee hach granted bargained and sold to the said Arrington Britt and sell unto the said William Borodden his heirs & assigns forever and the said Tract of 12 Acres of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton & Parish of Totteray and bounded as followeth by the lands of West Syre by the lands of William Borodden and by the lands of Beisard Britt to have & hold the said Tract of Twelve Acres of land together with all and singular the houses edifices buildings yards Gardenways waters & meads thereon its boundaries and appurtenances unto the said land belonging or any thing appertaining to the same or any part or parcel thereof to have & to hold the said 12 Acres of land more or less with all and singular the premises mentioned with every part & parcel thereof unto the said William Borodden his heirs and assigns forever and the said Arrington Britt for himself his the said land with all and singular the premises unto the said William Borodden and assigns free from the claim or claims of him the said Arrington Britt his heirs and assigns and from all & every other person or persons who shall and will warrant and forever defend (as Trustee) by these presents I W M. Britt wherof the said Arrington Britt hath sworn to have and affixed this seal the day & year first above written

Chapman This Indenture made the twenty eighth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven between Alexander D^r Chapman of the first part Martha Lucy Fletcher wife of the said Chapman of the second part and John Maddill of the third part whereas a marriage recently solemnized by and between the said Chapman and the said Martha and whereas the said Martha D^r in the event of her surviving her husband Mrs Elizabeth L Maddill will leave the wife of her uncle Robert Maddill late of the County of Fincastle be possessed of a considerable personal estate slaves and money which is held by the said Mrs Elizabeth L Maddill during her life and whereas it is the anxious desire of the said Chapman to make provision for this said wife during her life & for any event happening to her which shall be subject to any casualty which may happen in his own life Now this Indenture witnesseth that in pursuance of the above mentioned & in consideration of the sum of one dollar of Lawful money of this Commonwealth paid by the said Alexander D^r in hand to the said John Maddill as before sheweth
