Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by the said Jesse Lankford to the said Samuel Griffin Eliza his wife Patsy & Eliza Griffin the receipt whereof is acknowledged these bargain and sell and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto Jesse Lankford his heirs and assigns forever all the right title profit share in one Tract of land whereon the said Samuel Griffin now lives containing estimation being seven & one half acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Jesse Lankford Patsy Turner Tammey Turner and William and furthermore doth grant bargain & sell confirm and convey all the estate in the said Samuel Griffin & Eliza Griffin his wife their heirs and assigns at any time may have in the undivided part of Miller's Turners lands to hold the said lands unto the said Jesse Lankford his heirs and assigns forever and also grant bargain and sell unto the said Jesse Lankford his heirs and assigns forever three factors two and furniture two pine chest six sitting chairs one beam one spinning wheel and all the household furniture of any kind whatsoever that the said Samuel Griffin has in his possession. To have and to hold the aforesaid property unto the said Jesse Lankford his heirs and assigns forever the covenants of this Indenture. Witnesseth that Samuel Griffin truly indebted to Eason Turner in three several notes which Eason Turner had upon or ever fully appear by reference to the record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County for the sum of one hundred & thirty four Cents including costs and commissions up to the second day of June
