This Indenture made and entered into this 20th day of October in the Year of our Lord 1827
 Between Mary S. Maget of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia William
 Blom of the same County and State of the second part, and Henry S. Williams of the County
 of Hertford and State of North Carolina. Witnesses that whereas the said Mary S.
 Maget of the first part being justly indebted to the said Henry S. Williams by promissory
 Note bearing date the 17th day of September last & on demand the same due for the
 sum of Two hundred and four Dollars and ninety five cents and the said Mary S. Maget
 being anxiously desirous of securing to the aforesaid sum of Two hundred and four Dollars
 ninety five cents together with the interest which at the time of the payment of the same
 may thereon lawfully have accrued Now this Indenture further witnesseth that the
 said Mary S. Maget for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid as well for & in
 consideration of the sum of one Dollar to her in hand paid by the said William
 Blom paid the receipt whereof she the said Mary S. Maget doth hereby acknowledge
 before the enclosing and delivery of these presents hath granted bargained and sold and
 do by these presents grant bargain & sell unto the said William Blom his Exors or admrs.
 the following property to wit, one negro Girl named Manora as two Head of Cows
 & furniture three horses fourteen head of Cattle thirty eight head of hogs thirty head of
 Sheep one Gig & Harness one Cart & wheels all my household & kitchen furniture To
 have & to hold the said property to the said William Blom his Exors or admrs. upon Trust
 nevertheless that if the said Mary S. Maget should fail to pay and discharge the aforesaid
 said debt with interest on or before the first day of January next then the said
 William Blom his Exors or admrs. when ever thereafter he shall proceed for the same to
 expose to public sale at such place as the parties may agree on first giving due
 notice of the same by advertisement set up and sell to the highest bidder for Cash
 and out of the proceeds of such sale first pay & discharge the cost attendant on the
 execution of this Trust and then pay to the said Henry S. Williams the aforesaid sum
 of Two hundred and four Dollars and ninety five cents as well as the interest thereon
 due and the surplus of any pay to the said Mary S. Maget or her Exors & admrs. if the
 said Mary S. Maget should on or before the aforesaid first day of January next pay
