Davis of the other part both of the County of Hancock & State of Georgia Whereas the said Jonathan for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred Dollars which of is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold & conveyed the same doth grant bargain sell & convey to the said Thomas M. Davis all that tract or parcel of land situate lying & being in the County of Southampton & State of Georgia adjoining lands of Samuel Turner & William Wells & others it being the tract left to said Jonathan by his late father John Turner dec^d containing by estimation one hundred and twenty five acres be the same more or less To have and to hold the said tract of land with all the rights members & appurtenances thereto belonging in any wise appertaining to the only proper use benefit & behoof of the said Thomas M.
