This Indenture made this 17th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred & twenty seven Between Reuben R Pope and Edmina his wife of the
County of Southampton & State of Virginia of the one part and Benjamin Edwards
of the county and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration
of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars to the said Pope in hand paid the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged the said Pope & Edmina his wife have granted bargained & sold
and by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the same Edwards his heirs & assigns
forever a Certain Tract or parcel of Land it being the same Tract on which the said
Pope now resides lying and being in the County and State aforesaid bounded on the
West and South by the Land belonging to the Estate of Benjamin Blount dec^d on
on the by the Land of Capt Thos Nicholson and on the North by the Land of
Bennett Jones Containing one hundred & fourteen acres be the same more or less
with all the buildings benefits improvements and privileges thereto belonging except
that the Grave Yards on the said Land the said Pope & wife do not hereby grant
and sell to the said Edwards. To have and to hold unto the said Edwards his heirs
& assigns forever which the said Land we the said Pope & Edmina his wife do
warrant & defend the title of to the said Edwards and his heirs & assigns forever
against the claim or claims of any person whatever. In Witness whereof we the said
