Claude at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have ~~granted~~ bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Joseph H. Claude his heirs and assigns forever a certain Tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton at the West end of the Tract of Land which the said Ramsay now possesses which Land came by his Wife containing five acres to the same more or less and bounded as followeth (To Wit) beginning at an ash in or near the run of the Spring Branch thence a South Course up a Gully to Two Log Cabin spruce four and after thence as South Course to a large forked white oak a few yds in the Smith or Charrell Land & bounded by the said Smith Land and the said Joseph H.
