This Indenture made this 15th day of September in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven between Joseph G. Council & Judith
his wife of Southampton County of the one part and Robert Hart of the said County
of the other part witnesseth that the said Joseph G. Council and Judith his wife for
and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to them in hand paid by
the said Robert Hart at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain
and sell unto the said Robert Hart his heirs and assigns all their right title and interest
in a certain Tract of Land lying in the County of Southampton aforesaid it being
a Tract of Land known by the name of Miles Estey's plantation which said Land
has been recently sold under a decree of the District Chancery Court of Williams-
burg by the Marshal of said District at which sale the said Joseph G. Council & Robert
Hart became the purchasers which will more fully appear by reference to the Marshal's deed
executed to them of record in the County Court of Southampton and the reversion and
dividends remainder and remainders yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof
and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said Tract of Land with the
fences buildings and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned
or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their
rights members & appurtenances unto the said Robert Hart his heirs and assigns
forever and the said Joseph G. Council and Judith his wife for themselves and their
heirs the said Tract of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances
before mentioned unto the said Robert Hart his heirs and assigns free from the claim or
claims of them the said Joseph G. Council and Judith his wife or either of them
their or either of their heirs and of all and every person or persons whomsoever shall
