convey and sell again conveyed and confirm unto the said John Titcher his heirs
& assigns forever one certain quantity or parcel of land containing as follows
situate seven and one half acres more or less lying in the County of Southamp-
ton and bounded as follows to wit beginning at said John Titcher's line and
then Delilah Courtine and Sally Titcher's Thomas Gary's line to Thomas
road thence the said road to the said John Titcher's line to the beginning
and fifty acres that lies in the said county about one half mile from the above
mentioned tract toward as follows beginning on James Jones do? line
thence the said line to Thomas Gary's line and thence to Benjamin Williams
to the beginning more or less and reversion and reversions remainder and
remainders rents and services of the said land and premises also all the Estate
right title Interest claims and demands of him the said Talbot West his
heirs of in and to the said lands and every part thereof. To have and to hold
