Parker This Indenture made the sixteenth day of July in the Year eighteen hundred &
Twenty seven between Harrison Parker as adm^r of Henry Gardner dec^d of Southampton
County and State of Virginia of the one part and Albrighton Jones of the same County
and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Harrison Parker as adm^r of the
said Henry Gardner for and in consideration of the sum of thirty one Dollars to him in hand paid by the
said Albrighton Jones at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Harrison Parker as adm^r of the said Henry Gardner
granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the
said Albrighton Jones his heirs and assigns forever all the cypress and Fir timber standing
growing or standing or hereafter to grow out of the tract of Land now owned and occupied by
the said Albrighton Jones being in the County aforesaid and bounded by the lands of
Edwin & Thomas Proffitt John Birdsong dec^d the late Abner Mitchell dec^d his
Brother & Jacob Garden and by Black Water and Norway Rivers which said timber
was conveyed to the said Henry Gardner by deed of bargain and sale from the said
Albrighton Jones bearing date the 6th day of December 1816 as will appear by reference being
had to the records of the aforesaid County. To Have and to hold all the timber of the growth
aforesaid now growing or to grow to him the said Albrighton Jones his heirs and assigns
forever and the said Harrison Parker as adm^r of the said Henry Gardner and as such only doth and will by these
presents warrant and forever defend the said bargained premises against all persons
whosoever or whomsoever to him the said Albrighton Jones his heirs and assigns forever
