This Indenture made this 17th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven between James Stephenson of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and George Stephenson and Edmund Stephenson of the County and State aforesaid of the other part.
Witnesseth that whereas I the said James Stephenson for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to him in hand paid by the said George and Edmund Stephenson the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
that this day bargained sold conveyed and confirmed unto the said George and Edmund Stephenson of the County and State aforesaid a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid containing by estimation Two Hundred Acres by the same more or less more or less bounded as follows by the land of Peter Edwards & Burnell Harris & with Harris a part thereof contained by the lands of said Stephenson which land formerly belonged to William Little and
have and to hold the said bargain promised with all and singular the appurtenances therunto the said George and Edmund Stephenson their heirs and assigns forever
and I the said James Stephenson do for myself my heirs & executors forever defend the said Land against the right title claim or interest of all and every other person or persons whatsoever In witness whereof I the said James Stephenson have hereunto set my hand and seal this the day and date above written

This Indenture made this 8th day of December Eighteen hundred and twenty seven between James Stephenson of the County of Southampton and Parish of St Lukes of the one part and Lewis Harris of the aforesaid County and Parish of the other part. Witnesseth that the said James Stephenson for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundreds and Thirty Dollars to him in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I the said James Stephenson doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold aliened and confirmed unto the said Lewis Harris his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land containing sevety eight acres and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a post oak a corner of Peter Edwards land in Lewis Harris's dwelling house along the said Edwards line to a common road thence down the said road to the said Edwards other lands thence along the said Edwards line to the northwest Lewis Harris's other lands thence along this line to the beginning containing sevety eight acres of land more or less to have and to hold the said sevety eight acres Land with all and singular the appurtenances thereunto belonging the said Lewis Harris his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Lewis Harris his heirs and assigns forever and the said James Stephenson doth further give his bond to pay unto the said Lewis Harris his heirs and assigns with the said Lewis Harris his heirs and assigns that he and James Stephenson my heirs ever of record shall and will warrant and forever defend the above mentioned Land of premises unto the said Lewis Harris his heirs and assigns forever against the claim and all persons or persons whatsoever In witness whereof I the said James Stephenson hath hereunto set my hand and affixed
