This Indenture made the 20<sup>th</sup> day of January in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five between John Lawrence and William Harrill of the one part and James Scott late of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia witnesseth that the said Harrill doth his wife Sally his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand and fifty five dollars to them to be paid by the said William Harrill as and before the executing hereof doth hereby make presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Harrill his wife Sally his wife have granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth each of them with grant bargain and sell unto the said William Harrill his wife and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia and situated on back water river and marked and bounded as follows Beginning at a point corner of Exum Jenkins standing at the River bank then up said River the said corner thereof 42 Poles to a Cypress standing at the said River bank then west 85° west 190 poles to a small low wood near a red Oak in the late Peter Horn's line thence along said line N.W. 41 poles to a gum a corner and more or less the same 965 E 140 poles to a red Oak corner in Exum Jenkins then N 30° E 152 poles to the beginning containing One hundred and thirty two acres more or less the dimensions & boundaries remain undetermined & clearly and distinctly issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the premises & appurtenances before mentioned unto the said William Harrill his husband and assigns forever And the said Harrill doth and Sally his wife for him and their heirs the said tract or parcel of Land with all and singular appurtenances and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said William Harrill his husband and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Harrill doth and Sally his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall will and do warrant by power of attorney in writing which of the said Harrill doth and Sally his wife have herunto set their hands and seals the day of January first above written
