 these presents the receipt whereof they acknowledge they the said Hardy
 Grop & Sally his wife have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do
 each of them doth grant bargain and sell unto the said William Marshall his
 heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the
 County of Southampton in the State of Virginia and situated on the
 waters river and marked and bounded as follows Beginning at a pine
 corner of Edmund Jenkins standing at the River bank then up said River the
 several courses thereof 42 Poles to a Cypress standing at the said River bank
 then out S 85° west 190 poles to a small saw wood near a red Oak on the side
 Peter Moon's line thence along said line N 60° E 117 poles to a gum a corner and
 thence N 30° E 152 poles to a red Oak a corner in Edmund Jenkins
 then N 30° E 152 poles to the beginning Containing One Hundred and thirty
 a half acres more or less the reversions & reversions remainder and increments
 yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel
 thereof To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the premises
 appurtenances before mentioned unto the said William Marshall his heirs and
 assigns forever And the said Hardy Grop and Sally his wife doth warrant
 and their heirs the said tract or parcel of land with all and singular the premises
 and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said William Marshall his heirs
 and assigns free from the claims or claims of them the said Hardy Grop and
 Sally his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every other
 person or persons whatsoever Shall will and do against & for ever by their present
