 for and in consideration of the Circumstances aforesaid and the further consideration of one
 Dollar as aforesaid to the said Barron in hand paid by the said Gentry of the third part
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged that the said bargain and sell and by
 these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said George G. Gentry as Trustee
 aforesaid of the third part the above named negroes Alfred Moses Mason and Diana
 upon the special trust and confidence that is to say That should the said Peter Edwards
 and Arthur Middleton of the second part be or become as aforesaid to and upon the said trust
 likely to sustain any injury or inconvenience or trouble by their becoming security
 as aforesaid for the said Barron that in any and in every case it shall be lawful and
 it is the true intent and meaning of these presents that the said George G. Gentry Trustee
 aforesaid of the third shall at the request of either of the parties aforesaid hereto or their
 representatives after giving twenty days Lawful notice at the Court House door of the
 said County and two or three other public places proceed to sell the aforesaid tract or parcel
 of land with all the appurtenances and improvements thereto belonging upon the premises
 and also the above named negroes Alfred Moses Mason and Diana for cash current
 money of Virginia and out of the proceeds of which first pay & satisfy the said Ed-
 wards and Middleton of the second part the amount which they are likely to pay or become
 to pay as securities aforesaid and the all costs and charges incident to these presents
 and that the said Gentry of the third part Trustee aforesaid shall hold the balance
 remaining of any subject to the order of said Barron of the first and the said Henry
 Barron of the first doth warrant and defend the right and title of the above land together
 with the improvements and the above named negroes to the said Gentry Trustee
 aforesaid of the third part and the said Gentry Trustee aforesaid of the third part
 doth hereby agree and bind himself his heirs and assigns to do and perform what is here
 specified and intended for him to do and perform In Witness whereof the parties
 aforesaid to these presents have hereunto set their hands and seals this day & date first
