 shall well and truly pay the amount of the aforesaid bond when the same shall  
 become due then this Indenture to be void but if on the contrary the said Feltz  
 shall fail to pay and discharge the amount of said bond at the expiration of nine  
 months from its date then the said William Blong at the request of the said Miles  
 Cook shall setup and sell to the highest bidder at some public place in the County of  
 Southampton for cash the aforesaid property previously giving ten days publick  
 notice of the time and place of said sale and out of the proceeds of said sale first  
 pay and discharge the expenses attending the execution of this Trust and the  
 balance pay to the said Miles Cook his heirs executors &c and if any thereof shall be  
 any surplus remaining after paying the amount for which the said Miles Cook  
 may have paid or be compelled to pay pay the said surplus to the said Francis Feltz

 Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty seven between James Gray of the first  
 part William Blong of the second part and Miles Cook & Henry kindred of the third  
 part witnesseth whereas the said Miles Cook and Henry kindred hath been bound  
 security for the said James Gray in a Bond executed to the P. T. C. Fund administration  
 of Hampshire for the sum of one thousand and ninety four dollars and  
 fifty cents bearing date the 13<sup>th</sup> day of December 1827 and payable nine months from the  
 date and the said James Gray being willing and desirous to secure and bind  
 himself the said Miles Cook and Henry kindred from paying the aforesaid  
 sum of one thousand and ninety four dollars and fifty cents or any part thereof  
 doth agree to convey certain property heretofore solemnly mentioned to the said  
 William Blong for the benefit of the said Miles Cook & Henry kindred  
 Now this Indenture further witnesseth that the said James Gray for  
 in consideration of the premises aforesaid as well for and in consideration of  
 the sum of one dollar current money so bound in hand by the said William
