constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a Commission from the
Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the sixth day of December 1827 to take effect
from the expiration of the term of the present Sheriff and to continue in office until the
first Quarterly Court to be holden for the said County in the Year 1829 If therefore the said
Silas Sumnerell shall truly and faithfully collect account for and pay the Taxes imposed by
Laws and all assessments of Taxes due in the said County of Southampton also truly and
faithfully collect account for and pay the Militia fines imposed by Law and all assessments
of Militia fines due in the County of Southampton aforesaid and shall in all other things
truly and faithfully execute the ^{said} Office of Sheriff during his continuance therein then the
above obligation to be void otherwise it shall remain in full force and virtue
