Henry Briggs Thomas R. Gray & Robert Goodwyn & Shadrach Doykin
are hold and firmly bound unto William B. Giles Esq. Governor or Chief magistrate of the
Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of thirty thousand dollars
to be paid to the said Governor and his successors for the use of the said Common-
wealth For the payment whereof well and truly to be made we bind ourselves and each
of us our and each of our heirs Executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly
by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 21st day of January 1828
The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas Shadrach Doykin Silas Sum-
mersell is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a
Commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 6th day of
December 1827 to take effect from the expiration of the term of the present Sheriff and to
continue in Office until the first Quarterly Court to be holden for the said County
in the Year one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine If therefore the said
Silas Summersell shall well and truly collect all taxes and poor rates and accounts
for and pay the same in such manner as is by law directed and also all fines
forfeitures and amercements accruing or becoming due to the Commonwealth in
the said County and shall duly account for and pay the same to the Treasurer
of this Commonwealth for the time being for the use of the Commonwealth in
like manner as is or shall be directed in case of Public Taxes and shall in all
other things truly and faithfully execute the said Office of Sheriff during his contin-
uence therein then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force
and virtue

whereas the above named Benjⁿ Griffin hath been duly appointed a Commissioner
of the revenue in the County of Southampton on or after a tollway for the
ensuing Year. Now therefore if the said Benjⁿ Griffin shall well and truly and
perform all the duties required of him as Commissioner aforesaid by the Constitution
thereto then this obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue
