This Indenture made this 17th day of November one thousand eight hundred & twenty seven between Salathiel McMichael and Sophia his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and James Pope of the said County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Salathiel McMichael and Sophia his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand & eighty three dollars in hand paid by the said James Pope the receipt being hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold alien enfeoffed and confirmed unto the said James Pope and his heirs forever one certain Tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton & Parish of Saint Luke's containing by Estimation Seventy one acres be the same more or less bounded as followeth to wit beginning at Hickory a corner in James Worrell's line thence along said Worrell's line to a small pine a corner in the line of Mary McMichael thence along said Mary McMichael's line to a pine a corner of John Vick's land thence along said Vick's line to a pine a corner of Jacob Barnes thence along said Jacob Barnes line to a pine a corner of said Barnes in said James Worrell's line thence along said Worrell's line to the beginning together with all right title Interest claim or demands of in and to the said tract or land of them the said Salathiel McMichael and Sophia his wife To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances unto the said James Pope his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said James Pope and the said Salathiel McMichael & Sophia his wife for themselves their heirs executors & assigns & do forever warrant and defend the title the same and every part thereof against all and every person or persons whatever In Witness whereof the said Salathiel McMichael and Sophia his wife hath hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and date above written Signed sealed delivered & acknowledged
