Tucker cheily acre and one eighth of land lying and being in the County of Southampton by the same more or less and bounded as follows beginning at a corner black jack in Nathan Turners line running North 75^o 30' West 50 poles to the Centre of a piney a white oak in Benjamin Turners line then North 42^o 30' East 80 poles to a white oak then North 42^o 30' East 80 poles to a corner pine near the mouth of the land then South 53^o 30' East 68 poles to 2 small red oaks in the line then South 42^o East 80 poles to the beginning so and in consideration of the sum of one thousand forty dollars to him in hand paid or secured to be paid by said Charles R. Tucker and the said Jesse Turner & wife Mackey Turner do warrant and forever defend the right and title of said bargain and land to be good to the said Charles R.
