Witnesseth that said Littleton Prince for and in consideration of the sum of Three thousand dollars Lawful money to him in hand paid by the said Joel Prince the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge. The said Littleton Prince hath granted bargain and sold alien Enfeoffed & confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien Enfeoffed confirm unto the said Joel Prince & his heirs in certain tract or parcel of land lying being in the said County of Southampton and on the North side of the River of the said County and bounded as follows on the north by the land of Elizabeth Norton on the west by Howell Nicholson on the South by Seaborn's Mill pond and on the East by Joel Prince's land containing Forty eight acres be the same more or less it being the whole of the land conveyed to him by his father on the north side of the public square reference thereto being had will more fully appear with all houses ways profits and advantages whatsoever to the said tract or parcel of Land belonging or in anywise appertaining & also all the right title Interest Estate claim or demand whatsoever of him the said Littleton Prince of him & his heirs and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and premises unto the said Joel Prince and to his heirs and assigns forever and the said Littleton Prince for himself and his heirs the said tract or parcel of land with its appurtenances doth release and assigns. Shall and will warrant right defend against the claim of every person whatsoever claiming under him.
