This Indenture made the 15th day of November in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and twenty seven Between Stephen Murdough of the County of Southampton of the one part
and Edwards Parrells of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Stephen
Murdough in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars of lawful money
of that Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said Edwards Parrells at or before
the making and delivery of shute presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have bargained and sold and by shute presents do bargain and sell unto the said
Edwards Parrells his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying situated
and being in the County of Southampton and bounded by the lands of Henry
Briggs on the East Thomas Wray and Saml Briggs on the North the main
part of the Asparnack Swamp on the West Sipe Drury and Edwards Parrells on
the South containing three hundred and sixty acres be the same more or less
being the tract or parcel of land which the said Stephen Murdough purchased at
the sale of the late Thomas Parrells Esq^r which will more fully appear by reference
to the deed executed by Edwards Parrells Esq^r of Thomas Parrells Esq^r bearing date
the 15th day of November 1827 and duly recorded in the Clerk's Office of the
